

MENTOR PROGRAM

Program outline

This outline is a quick view of a mentor program that can be started to help new and improving players. This gives them the opportunity to have a “mentor” that is there to give them a hand and help them on their journey.

Program Levels

The mentoring program is divided into two levels. Each level has a minimum point requirement for the mentees and the mentors.

Program Level 1

Mentee requirement 0 to 149 Master points

Mentor requirement Must have at least 100 Master points more than the mentee

Program Level 2

Mentee requirement 150 to 299 Master points

Mentor requirement Life Master

Applications

Both the mentees and mentors complete an application to participate in the program. By submitting the application they understand the program and agree to abide by the requirements of the program.

Program Requirements

- All mentees and mentors must be Unit 502 members.
- Must have the proper number of points for the program.
- Agree to play or work together for a minimum of 6 sessions over 6 months
- They set up their own schedule for their games or sessions.
- Each participant pays their own table/game fees.
- Can use computer bridge or other electronic training methods
- Mentors and mentees are matched up by the Mentor Program committee.
- Personality conflicts between mentor and mentee should be brought to the Mentor Program committee and new partners will be assigned.
